Merger or acquisition

Upgrade to a new system which combines access control with other functions, enabling employees or students to carry a single credential for many purposes.



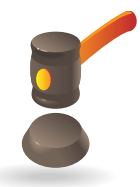
Risk management

Changes to requirements

New legislation, regulatory requirements, new client or building tenants requiring increased security.



Strong authentication adoption

Transitioning to Seos and biometrics enables the implementation of the highest levels of security, including strong authentication at the door.

Security incident

Ideally organisations should upgrade before there's a problem, especially if the current system uses legacy technology which increases the risk of a breach.
